




Memorize the prayer Jesus taught.

Most of all, God's plan made a way for you to be forgiven of your disobedience so that you could walk and talk with your Heavenly Father as Adam and Eve once did.

The Father's plan allowed you (and all people) to pray and to place all of your disobedience upon Jesus, His Son.

Our sin had to be taken away so that we could be a friend of God and walk with Him again. That is what Jesus came to do - He came to take away the disobedience of sin.

Some people didn't believe Jesus was the Son of God. They wanted to kill Him. They put Jesus on a cross, and His blood ran down into the ground, and He died. Then, they laid Jesus in a grave.



While Jesus was in the grave for 3 days and 3 nights, He went to Hell where Satan lives, and He took back the rulership and authority of the earth. Jesus took back all that was lost in the Garden of Eden.

God the Father kept His promises!

God, the Father, promised Adam and Eve He would send someone to crush Satan. God, the Father, sent His very own Son, Jesus to defeat sin and Satan!
